<p>Novice Practice Chanter: two-parted march: any time signature. Must never have competed in a piping contest.</p> <p>Grade 5 - one two-parted march, once over Grade 4 - one four-parted 2/4 march Grade 3 - one four-parted 2/4 march, four-parted strathspey and four-parted reel</p> <p>All light music tunes must be four-parted as a minimum for the events listed below:</p> <p>Grade 2 - two (2) four parted 2/4 marches, one (1) four parted strathspey, one (1) four parted reel, and one (1) four parted jig or two (2) four parted 6/8 marches</p> <p>Grade 1 - two tunes for each event. All marches submitted shall be in 2/4 time signature, or in the event of a 6/8 march contest, marches shall be submitted in 6/8 time signature.</p> <p>Professional - For professional march, strathspey and reel, hornpipe and jig, competitors shall submit four tunes of each type and shall play one tune of each type as chosen by the judge in any combination from the tunes submitted. For professional jig competitors, competitors shall play the tune chosen by the judge twice through. - Solo entries must be received at least 3 weeks prior to the contest date
- No field entries for any events other than the Drum Major contest
- Competitors are required to be current members of PPBSO or an officially recognized affiliated organization; non-PPBSO members please supply a photocopy of your current membership card, or similar proof with your entry
- Full payment must accompany each entry
- Events may be withdrawn at the discretion of the PPBSO Board of Directors
- Positions and starting times will be available for each solo entrant on our website at www.ppbsso.org
- Contests are scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m. sharp
- **Competitors Must Check in with the Steward Before the Event Starts** - Any competitor failing to play when requested by the steward may be disqualified. No refund of entry fees will be made for events entered but not competed in unless the event is cancelled. With the exception of Grades 4 and 5, all solo piping competitors must perform final tuning without assistance. Individuals exceeding the allowable tuning times may be disqualified. Allowable tuning time is 3 minutes for each event except piobaireachd, which has an allowable tuning time of 5 minutes. Competitors may be prevented from competing for not wearing proper highland dress. Kilt, shirt, hat, hose and shoes are the minimum requirement. When more than one tune is required to be submitted, the judge will decide the tune to be played.
- Solo Championship Supreme Points Calculation: Refer to the web page www.ppbsso.org or PPBSO Executive. Points earned at Amateur solo events at sanctioned Branch Indoor contests may be included.
